Randy McCoy reelected to PERS Board of Trustees



Dr. Randy McCoy, retired superintendent of the Tupelo Public School District (2002-2009), has been reelected as one of two retiree representatives on the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi (PERS) Board of Trustees.

At its April 23 meeting, the Board certified the results for the retiree representative term that runs from July 2025 to June 2031. McCoy was reelected to the Board, earning 50.06 percent (11,949 votes) of the 23,867 votes received.

The 10-member PERS Board includes the state Treasurer, a gubernatorial appointee who is a member of PERS, two retirees, two state employees, and one representative each of public schools and community colleges, institutions of higher learning, counties, and municipalities. With the exception of the state Treasurer and the gubernatorial appointee, board members are elected to staggered sixyear terms.
