George Dale reelected to PERS Board of Trustees



George Dale, former Mississippi commissioner of insurance, has been reelected as a retiree representative on the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi (PERS) Board of Trustees.

At its April 26 meeting, the Board certified the results of the runoff election between Dale and Bonnie Granger, former chief financial officer for the Hattiesburg Public School District.

Dale's new term will run from May 1, 2023, to April 30, 2029.

The 10-member PERS Board includes the state Treasurer, a gubernatorial appointee who is a member of PERS, two retirees, two state employees, and one representative each of public schools and community colleges, institutions of higher learning, counties, and municipalities. With the exception of the state Treasurer and the gubernatorial appointee, board members are elected to staggered six-year terms.
