Dear Gentlemen,

Thank you for your previous support of PERS. In accordance with the Board's current funding policy, I am writing to recommend a future employer contribution rate equal to the actuarial determined contribution (ADC) of 25.98 percent of payroll based on the latest report. The most recent PERS Annual Valuation Report as of June 30, 2025, is attached and available at <a href="https://www.pers.ms.gov">www.pers.ms.gov</a>.

For illustration purposes only, the annual difference between the above percentage and 19.90 percent of payroll is estimated at approximately \$453 million per year. Please note this is not a one-time cost. The recent engagement, interest, and commentary on the funding of PERS is encouraging. We are optimistic this upcoming legislative session may yield additional, significant, recurring funding, which is very important.
